138			Chokeberry-Red	Grows to 5-8', wildlife, birds, people, jam, jelly, likes shade and wet sites
139			Cranberry-Highbush	Grows to 8-15', birds & most animals, many soils & likes water
140			Dogwood-Red Osier	Grows to 3-15', eye-catching, birds and pollinators, moist soils
141			Elderberry-Black	Grows 5-10', wildlife, people, jelly, wine, medicinal plant, likes forest edges
142			Hazelnut-American	Grows to 6-15', grouse, moose, most animals, rich-moist soils
143			Hazelnut-Beaked	Grows to 15-25', most animals especially grouse, loam-sand
144			Holly-Winterberry	Grows to 3-10', likes acidic soil, for birds, toxic to people/dogs
145			Mountain Ash/Rowen	Grows to 10-30', most animals, easy to grow, most soils, pretty
146			Mulberry-Red	Grows 30-50', all animals, birds, bees, people, fruit, jam, good for poor soils
147			Plum-American	Grows to 10-30', animals, erosion control, most soils, hardy
148			Serviceberry-Downy	Grows to 10-20', animals, likes openings, many soils, does not like contaminated soils
149			Witch-hazel	Grows 10-20', medicinal use, dowsing rods, likes shade and water

150			Basswood	Grows to 60-100', birds, bees, butterflies, many moist, mesic soil types
151			Birch-River	Grows to be 40-90', birds, deer, hummingbirds, wetlands, riverbanks, moist soil
152			Birch-Paper	Grows to 30-60', moose, birds, pulp wood, deep well-drained soils, boreal forest
153			Birch-Yellow	Grows 60-80', deer, grouse, moose, songbirds, good with hemlock, bad with sugar maple
154			Elm-Slippery	Grows to 70', long-lived, moist to dry calcium rich soils, medicinal plant
155			Maple-Red	Grows to 60-90', most animals, well drained soil
156			Maple-Silver	Grows to 35-55', grows quickly, erosion control, likes water, weak wood, wildlife
157			Maple-Sugar	Grows to 90-120', most animals, maple syrup, sandy-loam
158			Oak-Bur	Grows to 70-80', large acorns, wildlife, deer, many soils, can handle drought
159			Oak-Swamp White	Grows to 50-60', likes sun, acorns, wildlife, acidic moist, well-drained soils
160			Oak-White	Grows 80-100', acorns, wildlife, slow growing, lives a very long time, many soils
161			Oak-Red	Grows to 70-90', lives very long, slow growing, timber, many soil types, stream banks
162			Walnut-Black	Grows to 50-75', plant alone can kill other plants, most soils
163			Willow-Black	Grows to 10-60', fast growing, loves water, erosion control
